The Escondido 2 group will meet the first Wednesday of every month at 6:30 PM at the Escondido Public Library (In the Pioneer Room, 239 S. Kalmia St., Escondido, CA 92025). The first meeting (which is informational only, no book is assigned) is Wednesday, Feb. 7.

Members are responsible for obtaining their own books for each meeting, either by purchasing a printed or digital copy or borrowing from a library. Remember: You can join only ONE group; if accepted you'll be notified as to which group. In order to make discussions easy and fun, membership is restricted to about 20 members in each group.
